NAYC youth charity is offering a unique opportunity for Bursaries to enable schools in Wolverhampton to experience adventure activities at Pioneer Centre, a facility of NAYC.

How much bursary funding is available?

Up to £1500 bursary is available per school per group booking.

Who is the bursary available to?

This bursary is for Primary/ Secondary Schools/Academies in the Wolverhampton area who would not otherwise be able to afford a school residential trip.

What is this bursary funding for?

The bursary is for a school residential activity package at Pioneer Centre, a facility of NAYC.

What does it cover?

The bursary will subsidise or cover the total cost of a 3 day or 5 day school residential activity package at Pioneer Centre; taking place Monday to Wednesday, Wednesday to Friday or Monday to Friday during school term time for 12 or more students and 2 accompanying teachers/adults.

The bursary may be applied to cover the costs for individuals and/or subsidise the cost per person for a School Activity Package at Pioneer Centre.
